1. Micropath 2001 VHF/UHF/MW Path Profile and Link Analysis software is now being released under a new name. PATHANAL will replace the Micropath 2001 name which has been used for approximately 10-years.
2. Direct PDF printing has been added to PATHANAL V4.0.1. During the PATHANAL installation process, a Micropath PDF Printer is installed. Project files that contain multiple links can now print each path profile and each link analysis to a single PDF file.
3. Batch processing of path profiles is now supported through a CSV file import. You create a CSV file in a specific format, import into PATHANAL, and the corresponding links with path profiles are created.
4. The Route Map program is scheduled to be released during June 2008. Radio link system diagrams are generated from a user created data base of sites, dragging the SiteLocDB Site ID's onto the route map form and clicking a button to display the Route Map. Creating the site database (SiteLocDB) is accomplished by importing a CSV file of site information or manually entering the site information into RouteMap. There is very little typing in the program once SiteLocDB has been created or imported. PATHANAL will export a SiteLocDB CSV file for importing into RouteMap (Export PATHANAL links to a CSV file, import the CSV file into RouteMap, drag and drop the SiteID's to create the links, click on Display Route Map - All with no typing!) We have also added a screen to display your route map on Google Maps.
